There will be plenty of class exercises, writing assignments and individual and group presentations.

Class Goals: By the end of the year, students will be able to

- 1. Think about and articulate their worldview.
- 2. Immediately recognize the different fallacies & arguments in communications, and put them to use in both oral and written form.
- 3. Think critically and remember what they have learned.
