Teacher Compensation Fee: \$225 Yearly payable in 9 installments of \$25 per month.

Required: A sewing machine and basic sewing tools are required.

Parental help for all students is encouraged, <u>but students under 10 are required to have</u> <u>an adult helper with them in class</u>. The adult helper does not need sewing experience.

Class Description: This class will teach sewing basics, using both hand and machine techniques. In the 1st semester we will do projects as a group, focusing on basic skills. In the 2nd semester, students will have the opportunity to practice their skills on free-choice projects.
