**Grade Levels:** 8<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>

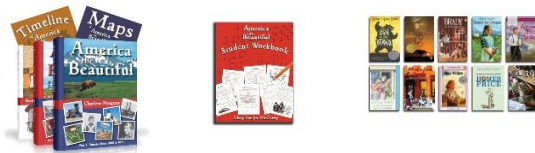
**Teacher Compensation:** \$270.00 annually, payable in monthly installments of \$30.00

**Semester Supply Fee:** \$50 annually (two payments - \$25 per Semester Due for Fall & Spring/January).  
Fall Semester Fee is due 1st week in July to secure place in class.

**Class Description:** In this 2-credit course, we will discover how beautiful and exceptional our great country is. Using the Notgrass books America the Beautiful, we will journey chronologically through American history, highlighting key events, people, and places. Along the way, Students will be reading great works of literature and completing at least 1 writing assignment per week.

**Note:** Expect a homework equivalent for 2 classes: History and English! The work level in this course will not be the same as a single class at LLAA. This is a rigorous course and students must be able to keep up with the work. Timely assignments are required. Homework expectation is 1 to 2 hours per day for 4 days per week.
