Class Description: This class will cover different genres of art forms from music, paintings, architecture, and much more. This will be a weekly interactive class in which students learn how to analyze art forms through one's visual, listening and emotional perspectives. There will be reviews and testing on learned art information.

There are two Semester Projects involving a detailed report/term-paper and a classroom presentation for each. The First Semester Project will be a group project of teams made of 2-3 students to work on a form of art together. This will help the student work in a team environment and will help them communicate and share different talented perspectives on their chosen art form. The Second Semester Project will be an individual project and will require a classroom PowerPoint presentation of 5 minutes or less. A short term-paper for this Second Semester Project will be required. Students will be challenged to be creative and innovative, and with lively discussions and interesting art, it's sure to make the class interesting.
