Class Description: This class is all hands-on. Prepare to be creative and get messy. Students will learn the fundamental necessities of design, shading, color schemes, color theory, and texture. We will use a variety of mediums to explore the different elements of design: advertising, fashion, architecture, landscaping, floor plans, interior design, story boards, marketing, etc. We will discuss how to define and reach your target audience. We will introduce some basic skills for preparing your artwork to go to print production. Students will be allowed to apply their newly learned skills in several independent design projects.
