**Teacher:** Tara Yen

**Grade Levels:** 9-12th

**Class Size:** Minimum 6 students, Maximum 12 students

**Teacher's Compensation:** \$225 yearly, payable in 9 monthly installments of \$25

**Fall Semester Supply Fee:** \$20.00. This covers the workbook needed for the class. Fall Semester Supply Fee is due 1<sup>st</sup> week in July to secure Student's place in class, or on Orientation Day if Student is late enrolled.

**Requirements:** Students are required to bring a notepad, pencil, and their provided workbook to class each week. Assignments will be passed out weekly and expected to be completed on time. In addition to completing assignments, students are required to spend 10 minutes a day on aural skills practice.

**Class Description:** In this class students will learn the fundamentals in music theory. They will learn how to read the staff, understand chord progressions, rhythmic notation, musical terminology, and analysis of sheet music. In addition to the written assignments, students will have a time of aural skills to learn to identify chords, and intervals. This class is great for students considering taking music theory in college.
